- Provide Essential Food Supplies - deliver direct assistance to needy children and their families in partnership with local communities in which they live
- Deliver Life-saving Emergency Relief - provide food, clothing, shelter, training and education to areas of world plagued by civil strife, war, and natural disasters such as floods and famine
- Prevent and Reverse Starvation – offer education, nutrition, and material support to pregnant and nursing mothers with young children to help prevent low birth weight and stunted development
- Eradicate Curable Diseases – distribute effective medications and medical services to suffering children and their families in rural areas where a simple treatment can mean the difference between life and death
- Promote Community Health - educate families on hygiene and basic food preparation practices that will help ensure lasting benefit from our outreaches.
